

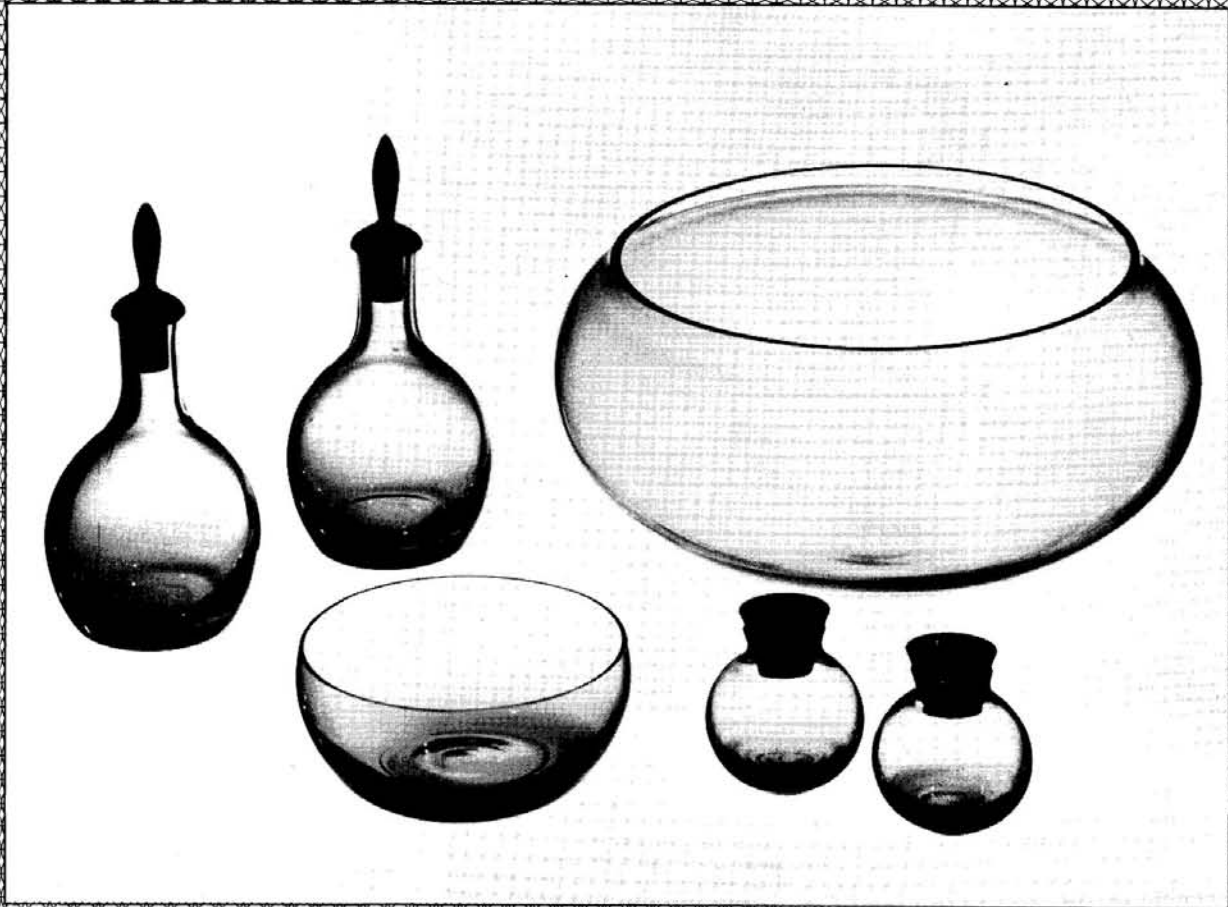

NOTES FROM YOUR PRESIDENT

In Memoriam



The days, weeks, and months keep passing by faster and faster. With deadlines it seems that as soon as one has been met, another looms in the immediate future. One of these deadlines is the presidents message.

To begin, I would like to take a few words to officially thank Liz Stickle for the hectic six weeks she worked as our membership secretary. As you may or may not, know, officers of H.C.A. may not receive payment for their services to the organization. The job was not easy, but made the training of our present secretary much easier. THANK YOU LIZ!

In the last three issues of the Heisey News reference has been made to OUR WAREHOUSE. I have received a number of inquires about the warehouse. Currently, as of Sept. 9. 1985, we are renting a warehouse on Wilson St. in Newark. We must be out of this warehouse by Nov. 13, 1985. This warehouse was available at the time we urgently needed storage space for the moulds. The rent is \$812.50 per month, based on the number of square feet used. The building would need extensive work to get it into satisfactory condition for long term storage. Also, after the first year, we have no guarantee that the rent would remain the same. With these conditions in mind the Executive Committee and Board began looking for another storage area. A warehouse became available on Clinton St. It was checked by the Executive Committee in early June which then recommended to the Board, that the building be purchased. The building is a brick and block shell approximately 40 x 70x22 ft. It has gas heat and electricity - but no water. There is a large parking lot at the front. The cost was \$35,000. with no down payment. The Board of Directors gave its approval at the June 1985 meeting. The monthly payment is \$445.00, based on a 15 year payment schedule. Additional expenses will include taxes, insurance (which we are already paying on the rented building) and heat. It is felt that a minium temperature of 45 degrees F. would help control condensation on the moulds - thus cutting down on rusting. An estimate of total monthly cost would be \$525.00 We have also been renting a mini storage space, at a cost of \$35.00 per month. Items stored in it will be moved to the warehouse - reducing the overall cost to approximately \$490.00 per month. The mini storage was used for books and items for sale in the gift shop. I hope this answers the questions raised, but if it doesn't, feel free to make further inquires.

MOULD FUND STATUS

As of the 16th of September, we have received the following cash and pledged monies:

The fund has only grown by \$900 the past 35 days and at this rate it will take us 3 years to reduce the \$30,000 debt. We need the pledged money as soon as possible to help pay the loan balance and interest.

Currently membership participation is at 48% and a little help from those who have not participated would put us a lot closer to the goal of \$229,000. You can still give if you haven't and remember your donation is tax deductible. I can't over stress how important it is to reduce the debt in the Short Term. Hopefully by the time you receive this the Moulds will all be moved to HCA owned warehouse which will reduce some of our monthly storage costs.

Please support this project with cash donations, pledges, purchase of the display sign and plate. Also we have received very small quantities of glass for auction. One or two pieces from each member would help significantly if you are unable to give otherwise. Remember together we can make the purchase and payment of the Moulds a reality.

FROM THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR



Another September Souvenir Dinner has come and gone. It was really a beautiful day but one of the hottest we had had all summer. Not a breath of air stirred for most of the day, and even after dark it was still hot.

The show in the tent was beautiful and we hope that all the dealers did well. The crowd was smaller than anticipated, no doubt partly due to the heat. There was little to buy that was not Heisey but there was plenty of that.

"Dealers" may not be the proper word to describe some of those who sell because part of them do no selling except at one or two Heisey events a year. It does help to sell a little and then buy a little more.

The dinner, cooked by Eleanor Jackson, our long time caterer, was delicious as usual and with the abundance of hors' d'oeuvres and beef tenderloin, no one could go home hungry.

The big red and white striped tent made a great circus setting and that theme was continued from June. Clever circus trains and circus wagons were made by the committee for table decorations. Balloons were tied to the chairs and were then sold for \$1 each which went to the mould fund.

Seventeen hundred dollars was realized from an auction of various items including some vases and animals made by Imperial. Colonel Dockery's jacket and cap sold once again. It always comes back.

The attendance was disappointingly low with only 124 attending - about the same as last year. With the return to the tent we thought we could perhaps catch the magic of the early days and attract bigger crowds.

We had to order a full turn of the little blue horseheads which are really very cute. There were 332 and we only sold 175. Last year we had the extras frosted and many were sold at the dinner. This year all that were not sold are being sent back to be frosted and they will be on sale while they last on a first come, first served basis. They will be \$35.00 each which includes shipping and tax (if applicable or you may pick them up at the museum.) We save 6 at least for our glass archives, and five were broken so about 146 will be available. Order quickly if you want any. No discounts on these, please. See page 23.

On that busy weekend, the many people who came from out of town to work and those who lived here managed to move seven semi loads of moulds to our own warehouse. They will be moving some again this week, so that probably they'll all be moved by the first of October. These people have given their all for this project. It is difficult to thank them individually but they have been wonderful. I am impressed by the warehouse. It looks very businesslike. We now have a good chance to be able to keep the moulds forever.

You must remember that before the moulds are moved they are tagged with the numbers on each of them and placed on larger pallets which are then put up on the metal racks with a forklift. It takes a team of about three to place the moulds on the pallet, number each pallet, tag each piece if it isn't already, and list the moulds on the particular pallet. It is exciting.

We still have a few black Oscars at \$24.00 each. Order soon if you want one. Diamond H signs and Victory plates are still available for the benefit of the mould fund. (See September Heisey News for the form.)

We still need Heisey glass for the gift shop. Nappies, plates, ash trays, coasters etc. sell well to the casual visitor who wants one piece of Heisey. We do very well with this and it is a great source of money for us.

Be sure to read Norma Gorsuch's letter about sending a Christmas gift to the mould fund. Most of us are in a mellow mood during the holidays and like to do something a little extra, anyway.

Be planning what glass you will be sending to the March auction. You may bring it anytime - 10 items to a family to sell; any amount as a gift.

I am sorry to break promises to print the donation lists and write about "little things" etc, but as you can see the Heisey News is full with so many ads this time.

We'll get all that done soon.

HEISEY CANDLESTICKS

No. 1447 Rococo was a rather small pattern of about 20 pieces which came out in the early 1930's. Most of the items in the line were serving pieces, with the exception of a cigarette box, a candlestick and a floral bowl. As the latter items might suggest, the pattern was primarily intended for the hostess who wished to entertain elegantly.

The earliest reference to the candlestick was on a factory worksheet dated December 13, 1932, which contained pricing information. It was probably first made later that same year and was introduced to the trade in early 1934. Although it continued to be offered in price lists until 1938, relatively few of the candlesticks seem to have been produced and they are scarce today.

The candlestick was also made in saharah and has been seen both with a crystal foot and in all saharah, but is rare in color. (The divided relish in the pattern was made in limelight -- the name given to zircon when that color was re-introduced in 1955 -- but the candlestick had been long discontinued by then.)

The design of the candlestick is very ornate and it is intriguing that the Rococo pattern was introduced simultaneously with the No. 4044 New Era pattern, one of Heisey's most simple and "modern" lines. This reflects the fact that the early 1930's was a transitional period. It is probably equally significant to note that, of the two patterns, New Era was by far the more popular.

The Rococo candlestick is 8 inches high and has an armspread of just over 7 inches. Most of the pieces in this line have a raised cameo surrounded by scrolls as a primary design motif, including the 12 inch oval floral bowl, which was intended to be a companion piece to the candlesticks. The cameo does not appear on the latter, however, although the same form can be seen in the hollow in the center of the arms. This candlestick was offered with at least four

cuttings:

803, Hialeah
816, Palmetto
832, Continental
835, Larkspur

but is rarely seen with any of them. It was also offered with the No. 600 and 601 satin finishes and the No. 5000 Bacchus carving, as well as the No. 477 Japanese Scene plate etching, which was available only on the console set from this pattern.

The candlestick is marked at the bottom of the stem, just above the base. It was not reissued by Imperial and, to the best of my knowledge, the mould is no longer in existence.

The Yachting Center boasts two Castles: One, built in 1926, overlooks the Harbor and is called "Ballards' Castle Bratahlid", which means "hewn out of rock". It was built entirely from stone, blasted out of a ledge on which it now stands. It hides a dungeon and secret stairway. The second Castle was built in the mid-thirties, overlooks the Ocean and is called "Carcassone". It was built by the granddaughter of Lydia Pinkham, who owned a medicine company, at a cost of \$500,000.00 Every year major fund raisers are held on the grounds, celebrities being flown in by helicopter. It is for sale for three million. It enjoys a swimming pool, tennis courts, elevator and several large rooms plus "Glass Staircases". I wonder what Mr. A. H. Heisey would think of that!

Now to get down to business, "my first convention Heisey friend" has found three (3) #5089 Princess 1 oz. cordials with the #507 Orchid etch. These "little things" are always a great joy to own. "Two Guys" (Conn) looking over a table full of glass, spotted a pair of #133 Swan Candlesticks in crystal with the foot and the candle-holder flashed blue. Price was being bantered about when the dealer pointed out a second pair on the other end of the table. He said they came from the same house as the first pair. Needless to say all four were purchased and toted home.

"Little old Lamplighter" from the Buckeye State (OH) is continuously lighting up his life! This time with a pair of #1488 Kohinoor 2-lite Candelabra with "D" prisms and to go with all this beautiful light was a 14" floral bowl. Are you ready for this - - all the above pieces, and I underline the word all, were cut with the #890 Churchhill cutting. 'An absolutely beautiful set.' Now, sitting right next to these lovely candelabra, and bathing in the light from the same, were two (2) Ringneck Pheasants. Hope that was enough excitement for one day. What joy!

"Mountain Gal" (CA) is up to her old tricks in spite of the "killer Bees" found near her place of residence. She trucked on down to a lady's house that had some pink glass, stored in boxes that she wanted to sell. She thought maybe it was Fostoria. The first box held a #134 Trident candlestick in Sahara with Old Colony etch. 'Mountain Gal' perked up and kept going thru the boxes. A whole box of Heisey in Sahara with Old Colony etch, covered with coat after coat of dirt from years of storage. All pieces were purchased and taken home to be washed to a brilliant sparkle and listed: #1401 Empress - Eight (8) 8' Plates, four (4) cups and saucers, 11' Floral Bowl d/f and a 8½" footed floral bowl handled. #3380 Old Dominion - seven (7) saucer champagnes - Seven (7) 10 oz goblets, tall - three (3) 3 oz cocktails and one (1) 4 oz claret. All the above are Sahara and Old Colony etch. By the way "Mountain Gal" has sold her "mountain truck" and her "lil red MG" and is now hunting in a "Heisey Honda". Good luck! She seems to have plenty of that.

How are our "Rebel Cousins" (KY) making out a after a long hot summer? I say pretty well; #1632 Lodestar 6¼" bowl, Dawn; #1280 Winged Scroll ash tray that goes with the smoking set, custard; and a very elegant #1519 Waverly Candy jar with the Elk Etch.

Off to the Sunshine State (FL) and "My English Buddy" where he is enjoying the warm weather and his #1404 Old Sandwich Decantur in crystal.

The "Mr" is forever keeping his eyes open for all sorts of good things. Yesterday he brought me a real nice present. Not glass. It is a very "old" little drop leaf table 21¼" long - 7" wide - 22" high with drop leaves 10" long. When the table is open it is 27" wide. Inlaid around the border and cut on the edges and legs. Little, Old & Cute! Other than that the "Mr" found a #351 Priscilla Tooth-pick and a pair of #112 3" Candlesticks in Moongleam.

"The Spirit" (NJ) from the Garden State has in her proud possession a #160 Locket on Chain Spooner in Emerald. While a "new convention couple" found a Rooster Stopper and a #433 Greek Key 2 pint Crushed Fruit Jar.

Watch out "Rebel Cousin" that "Yankee from Pa" has a terrific little #325 Pillows Cracker Jar, both top and bottom are marked. He didn't tell me where he was when he bought it. Pretty nice!

From the Buckeye State (OH) I hear of a #150 Pointed Oval and Diamond Point Covered sugar in Emerald. This little beauty completes his table set. What a thrill, it must be gorgeous.

There is an "eager beaver" in the Buckeye State that has an eye for beautiful and rare things. He hardly ever fails to come up with a treasure or two. Here goes: Another Hilo Vase in Flamingo; (oh yes, I did say another didn't I - now the little "eager" has two. Moongleaaamm wiiith envy!) #1485 Saturn goblet - no optic- but with English Ivy Etch plus an handsome #351 Priscilla Pilsner in Cobalt - this is quite a rare find. The Hilo vase and Pilsner are on loan to the museum so we can all enjoy them.

"The Cal Kid" works hard both in school and on the field; he has come up with another Tangerine Ivy Vase, his third one. Some people have all the luck, I've never found even one. Also four (4) #1503 Crystalite footed tumblers.

The "funny talking couple" from the Badger State (WIS) had a strange but nice experience on their way north from Florida. On their first stop they found a #1201 Fandango Berry bowl with ten (10) sauce dishes to match were spotted on a shelf and purchased. Now when they arrived at their home port they did the rounds of a few familiar shops and came up with another real goodie. Perhaps you would all like to guess what pattern it was. Did you guess? You did. Right you are it was #1201 Fandango covered Horseradish Jar with fair gold. Tremendous - fourteen (14) pieces of Fandango.

The Bay State hasn't even been mentioned and they certainly can not be left out so let me tell you what "the hanging judge" has purchased. #1255 Pineapple and Fan salt with #10 top.

As for "Yours Truly" I've been lucky enough to acquire a lovely 12" #4182 plate - marked - with the Mah Jongg double plate etch. The small rectangles surrounding the plate are designs taken from tile used in the Oriental game of Mah Jongg. A picture can be seen in the Aug. Heisey News.

ORIGINAL NUMBERS FOUND FOR HEISEY SYRUPS

For many years we have had copies of patents for several Heisey syrups but have not known their correct pattern numbers. Recently four of these have been found due to the generosity of Harold and Mildred Willey who loaned the patent book kept by the Heisey Co. of their current patents. The book lists the pattern, the number, the piece the length of the patent, the date of application, the date granted and the number of the patent. The Willeys allowed the Museum to copy the book, so we now have the information on file in our archives.

All four of the syrups were designed by Andrew J. Sanford and assigned to the Heisey Co. The numbers are #365, #366, #369 and #370.

The patent for #365 syrup can was applied for on July 7, 1919 and granted on March 8, 1921. It was given design patent #57273 and the patent was for 14 years.

The patent for the #366 syrup can was applied for on July 7, 1919 and not granted until March 21, 1922. It was given design patent number 60706 and the term of the patent was for only 3½ years.

#369 is an unusual footed syrup can. The patent on it was applied for on July 8, 1919 and it was granted design patent number 57274 on March 8, 1921.

The last new number, #370, was given design patent number 57272 on March 8, 1921. It was applied for patent on July 7, 1919 also. #369 and #370 had patent terms of 14 years each.

Do any of you have these Heisey syrups? I can't recall seeing any of them. How about it, Jim?

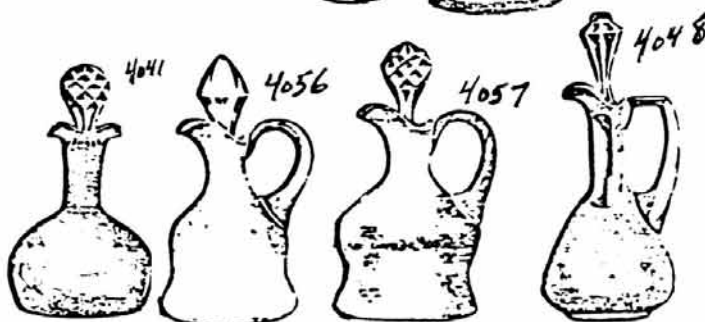
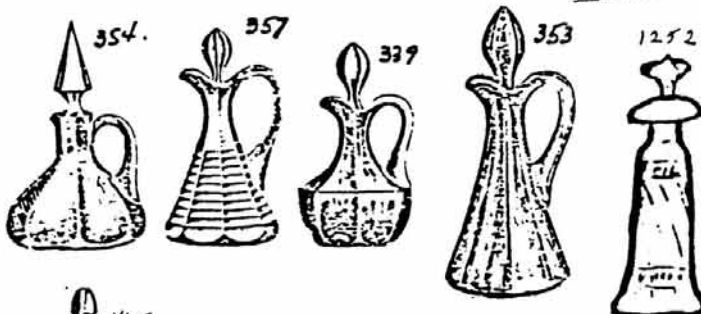

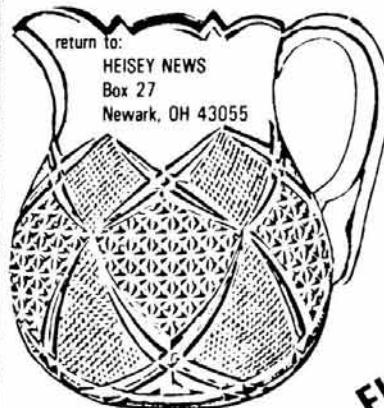
