He was the designer of many of the Heisey animals and he also designed the Dancer Leg Cocktail glass. Rod Irwin was Heisey Sales Manager for many years.

HEISEY BY IMPERIAL - NO. 1570 LOTUS LEAF BY TOM FELT

When the Imperial glass archives were being sold off, a year or so before the factory went out of business, and I first saw the candleblock on the right in the accompanying photograph, I didn't recognize it. It was only on the second glance that I realized there was something familiar about it: that it was, in fact, made from the mold for Heisey's No. 1570 Lotus Leaf candleblock.


What makes it look so different is that this version has a cupped base, which makes it stand almost twice as tall as the Heisey original, with a correspondingly smaller diameter at the base. (The Heisey candleblock is between 1½ and 2 inches tall with a diameter at the base of 4 inches. The Imperial candleblock is 3 inches tall and 2½ inches across at the base.)

The Imperial candleblock is actually in the form it would have been upon being released from the mold. In the case of the Heisey original, it would have been flattened out by hand afterwards (which accounts for the fact that the height of the Heisey candleblock often differs, depending upon how much it was flattened).

The No. 1570 Lotus Leaf was one of Royal Hickman's designs and was produced by Heisey from 1947 to 1949, with more than 2,000 pairs made. It is sometimes marked on the bottom with the Diamond H, Though often very faintly. (Perhaps because it was obliterated by the wooden paddle used to flatten the base?)

The Imperial reissue is marked LIG, indicating that it was made sometime during the period during which Lenox owned the company, from 1973 to 1981. It does not appear in any catalogs, but the fact that it is marked at all probably means that it was at least briefly in production, and not just a feasibility item. Does anyone else have this candleblock or remember seeing it for sale in the Hayshed?

The quality of the glass is rather poor and very wavy. Also, the ribs on the cupped base are much sharper than on the Heisey candleblock. Because of the variance in shape and quality, and the fact that the Imperial candleblock is clearly marked, it is unlikely that anyone would ever confuse it for a Heisey original. Instead, it is a curious and enjoyable addition to a collection of Heisey by Imperial.



Crystal Care



- DO... have adequate space to store your crystal.
- DO... wash crystal in clean, pleasantly how water or one of the chemically prepared soapless powders.
- DO... rinse in clean, hot water. Add a few drops of ammonia or bluing to give luster.
- DON'T... use strong soaps or scalding water on decorated crystal.
- DO... dry crystal quickly with a linen towel, free of lint.
- DO... use diluted ammonia or tea leaves soaked in vinegar to loosen deposits that mar inner surface of crystal condiment pieces or flower vases.
- DON'T... let tumblers or pitchers stand with milk or fruit juice or any other liquid; rinse at once with cold water.
- DO... use a soft bristle brush for cleaning deep places of cut or pressed designs.
- DON'T... put anything hot in crystal that has been chilled.
- DO... put a silver spoon in a crystal cup before pouring in hot liquids.
- DON'T... stand a hot cup on a cold metal, enamel or porcelain surface.
- DO... try to smooth shallow nicks and rough edges with fine emery paper.
- DO... use a rubber mat, or a cloth in the bottom of the dish pan and drain board to reduce chances of chipping and nicking.
- DO...use a tissue between fine crystal plates when they are stacked. It will prevent scratching and marring.
- DO... have space between tumblers, cups or stemware when you line them up on shelves. Constant vibration and jarring may cause edges to chip.

THOSE ANIMAL DISHES AGAIN!

A letter from John Willoughby of Louisiana warns us that the animal covered dishes from Taiwan are still being advertised as HEISEY. Please, please don't buy these as Heisey. The mark is really not like the Heisey Diamond H. HCA was able to get AAA to remove this mark from the moulds but many were already on the market. Thanks, John, for keeping us informed. L.R.

Perhaps it would be interesting to learn how some of our "friends" started on the road to "Heisey Land". "The Scribe" (nj) related this saga to 'Yours Truly'. It was in the early 1960's and her mother presented the "Scribe" with the "green Christmas dishes" she had always used for their Christmas eve repasts during her growing up years. Her mom had purchased them in the 1920's and 1930's as gifts to her own mother for special occasions, birthdays, anniverseries, etc. The Scribe loved those pretty glass dishes displayed so beautifully on a snow white table with a centerpiece of Poinsettias in a lovely green bowl with green candlesticks and red candles, making the setting perfect. So "Christmasy" to be sure! It was in 1969 when the "Scribe" received some glassware from her Grandmother-in-law (no Héisey) and decided to find out what it was, so off to the library. She found a book that mentioned the A. H. Heisey Company and showed the diamond H trademark. Wow! Something rang a bell in her head - - that's the mark on her green dishes! Finally the address of the Heisey Collectors of America was found and the "Scribe" requested more information, joined the club, and purchased all back issues of the "Heisey News". The learning process began and the 'fever' grew. She still uses her "green Christmas dishes" every Christmas eve with the same thrill ever present. Some of the original set included (all Moon-gleam) #1231 Ribbed Octagon 3" candlesticks; twelve 7" plates; twelve saucers with ten cups; the hotel sugar and creamer; a #1229 Octagon $5\frac{1}{2}$ " D/O footed mayonnaise; a $5\frac{1}{2}$ " two-handled jelly. In #1184 Yeoman she has a 5" covered D/O lemon dish; #1210 Frog handled 6" cheese plate (quite a super piece there); #1401 Empress 10" celery and a #1202 11" floral bowl w/underplate. More regarding this next month.

"The Cardinal" was very pleased the day that he spent at a South Shore Glass Show as he was able to bring back the illusive #357 Prison Stripe 7oz tumbler to his nest. These tumblers are few and far between. Also acquired, as a gift, was an exquisite Harvey Amber tumbler (deep in color) and another majestic piece in the #439 Raised Loop 5oz egg cup. This is a very rare pattern from 1911 to 1915. The collection is growing by leaps and bounds. Good for you!

Now, how about a few things that were picked up by the "Wistful Wayfarer" - some with confidence and others with misgiving, but nevertheless, Heisey in all its splendor: she has five (5) sets of #1454 Diamond Point individual ash trays and individual jellies. (I like to call these sets "honey dishes"); #1567 Plantation 8" plates, perfectly plain (3 of these), a #1469 Ridgeleigh sugar and a pretty #1184

Yeoman covered candy, cut.

"The Advocate" (from La, the Pelican State) relates finding six (6) 8 oz Yorktown old fashions with the #9033 Houston Post, American Legion Bridge Club Etch - with the #456 Titania plate etching; there were also six (6) #1401 Empress 7" square plates with the same etch. He sent me a pencil rubbing of these two etchings and they can be seen on pages 203 and 130 of the etching book if you are lucky enough to have one.

"The Genial Gypsy" from the Bay State came up with the #355 Quator cream and sugar, while the "Busy Bee" bragged about eleven (11) #1225 Ridge

and Star plates in Flamingo.

The courts are back in session and that eminent Judge, Roy Bean, is again sitting on the bench. Several cases are in progress but the most prominent of these is the one against the two (2) #160 Locket on Chain salt and peppers. The ruby stain is good and the gold is also in good condition but, even so, the jury brought in a verdict of guilty as charged and the good Judge was forced to sentence the shakers to a life sentence, to be served on the second shelf of the cabinet in his den . . . Case Closed!!

"One Preacher and his Missus" took off for a much needed sabbatical; they had no special plans, just little shops, big malls, junk shops in various off-expressway towns, wherever their heavenly Honda decided to go. Discovered were many things, a few of which I'll disclose now and others will be forthcoming next month: one #341 40z low footed scalloped sherbet, a #1231 Ribbed Octagon cup in Flamingo (she already owned the saucer, so Voila! a set), next was a piece of #1503 Crystolite which she describes as 'praline shell shaped'. This last piece was found sleeping soundly on a junk table in a very musty basement full of "as is" furniture, which only goes to prove you never can tell!

While we are speaking of Crystolite let me report the things "Mr. Crystolite" discovered; a #1503 creamer, the marmalade and syrup. The syrups are a real find. Years ago "The Mr." and myself passed by the Crystolite syrup because we didn't know what it was. He also bragged about the Dr. Johnson Punch Bowl/Cover and frosted. This is a lovely piece and can be seen at this time in the 'real', at the Hei-

sey Museum as it has been placed on loan.

A "Friend in Deed" shares a frosted Rooster Vase and the #2352 soda with an unknown etch with us, while "The Wiz" claims a #5 11" candlestick, the #5072 Heisey Rose stem, a #3350 Wabash stem with the Pied Piper etch, the #3336 Lady Leg stem with Trefoil Needle etch and a #3317 Drake Stem with #33

Tatting Needle etch.

As for "Yours Truly", I came across a #1205 Fancy Loop 3oz wine plus the #379 Urn individual salt. I own the large urn 12" Orange Bowl and when you place these two pieces side by side they sure do look pretty funny.

Let's hope that the "Heisey Santa" is good to us all! Just remember, "the little Christmas presents

of today are the garage sales of tomorrow".





May Santa fill your socks with Heisey, Louise Ream










We will again have absentee bidding. Please, everyone participate either by supplying glass for the auction, or bidding, or do both. 


