About the Cover: Santa holds the #411 Rib & Panel (Tudor) goblet. This particular goblet is distinguished by its angular stem verses the #412 which has a round, #413 which has a straight and #414 having a cone stem. The production period for this stem is 1916-1950. The colors produced are Hawthorne, Moongleam and Flamingo. For more information see Heisey Stemware by Stephen H. Bradley, Constance S. Ryan and Robert R. Ryan. A copy can be reviewed in the HCA library.

From the Vice President, Sam Schnaidt

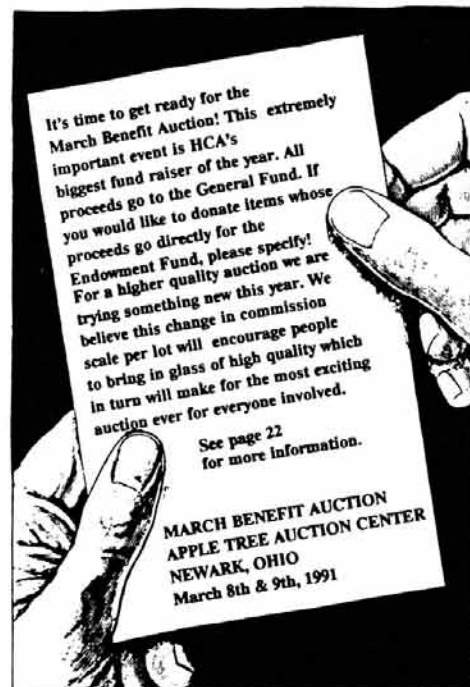

MARCH BENEFIT AUCTION

It has been brought to my attention that there may be some misunderstandings or perhaps even grumblings about the changes made in the commission structure for the upcoming benefit auction. I feel that it is my duty to explain this as I was the one who proposed this to the Auction Committee and the Board of Directors, who ultimately approved it.

It has always been the goal of HCA to make this the best possible auction. I will again go over the new commission schedule. Items selling from \$1.00-\$24.99 will be 30%. Items from \$25.00 - \$49.99 25%. Items from \$50.00- \$249.99 20%. Items from \$250.00- \$499.99 15% and any items over \$500.00 will be 10%. The \$5.00 minimum commission has been eliminated.

The reasoning is two fold. First, it takes as much time and cost to handle lower valued items as it does

higher valued pieces. In this way we are able to get a little more commission to help offset costs and time. Secondly and most importantly, we hope that people will be more willing to offer some rare, exciting and higher valued pieces because it will cost them much less to sell them and yet the club can still make more total proceeds.

I hope you will support this project as you have in the past and perhaps even to a greater extent with lots of exciting items. If this does not meet with approval it may be changed next year.

I know Jim Clark and his committee are looking forward to the best HCA auction ever held.

UPDATE FROM AUCTION COMMITTEE

Although there has been some confusion with the new commission scale, we anticipate another record setting auction with many participants through consignments and bidding.

A few volunteers and myself unpacked and catalogued the first 100 lots of glass on October 27th and it was just like Christmas.

The very first item to be unwrapped was outstanding-- a Spanish Stem with Pairpoint cutting. If this is any indication of the glass being sent in, this will be one fine auction! We unpacked glass with a good representation of colors and patterns ranging from #1201 to Colonial to the later patterns.

You "Orchid" lovers won't want to miss this auction. We have over forty pieces in the first 100 lots. A few of the favorites of those unpacking: a Winged Scroll toothpick in Custard, a beautiful Sunburst 3qt. jug, a small elephant, a beautiful Seahorse cocktail, a gorgeous Beaded Swag red stained toothpick, a Fancy Loop rose bowl and my favorite so far a 12" Optic tooth vase with Moongleam foot.

Remember January 1st is the deadline, so get your glass sent into the Museum.

I would appreciate any help you may want to offer with the auction. Just call me or the Museum to let us know how and/or when you can help. Our next unpacking and cataloging session will be Saturday December 1st in the shipping area of the Administration Building.

Thanks for your support. I'll give an update again next month. See page 22 for more info.

SUBSCRIBERS PLEASE
READ CAREFULLY
IMPORTANT INFORMATION
TO GO IN TO EFFECT
DECEMBER 1, 1990!**

After several months of getting used to the computer, the deadline and the needs of the advertisers and readers, I thought it would be a good time to clarify a few concerns.

I am constantly striving to improve the quality of the advertising section. I am also striving to improve communication between advertisers, buyers, and the Heisey News staff.

Deadline: Please remember that advertisements (with payment enclosed) must arrive by the 5th of the month prior to publication to be included. If advertisement and/or payment does not arrive by the 5th then the advertisement will be held until the next month.

Form to submit advertising: Please print or type ads double spaced. Accuracy is important to us. Make sure your ads are readable. If you are an advertiser, please check the accuracy of your information. Include pattern number, pattern name, item, decoration, color (if other than Crystal), H if marked, quantity and price. Don't forget your readers are both novices and experts.

Corrections: In the event of a typographical error, the corrected portion of the ad will run in the following issue. Notification of such an error must be made in writing by the advertiser to the Heisey News. The Heisey News assumes no further liability.

Lines not items: Excluding name, address and other information that appears at the top of the ad, the amount of information in an ad will be measured by lines instead of by items.

See chart at right for number of characters per line per display space. Characters are: all punctuation, letters, numbers, symbols and spaces. For example the last sentence has 70 characters and this sentence has 73.

The reason for this change is that often times a description for one item may run to two lines, therefore using more space which eliminates space for another item. Also some advertisers like to include other information about where they will show next or special services for their customers. I would like to be consistent and fair with every advertiser.

Camera ready ads: If you would prefer to send in your ads camera-ready (typeset & ready for printing) you are welcome to at your own cost. However, the

dimensions must be exactly as specified in the chart. The type style we use is called Dutch.
