This coloring book page design was adapted from the November 1929, issue of “Table Talk” – a periodical marketed towards vendors, dealers, and other sellers of Heisey glassware. This design was part of a selection that could be ordered and “supplied *gratis*,” in either “mats or electros,” for use in newspapers or similar advertising mediums. The glass pattern (i.e. the design or style) is not specified in the original advertisement; however, the glassware appears to be mostly a selection from pattern number 1184, also colloquially named “Yeoman,” and features Heisey’s “diamond optic.” The Yeoman pattern covers a range of several pattern numbers with and without and was produced between the years 1913-1957.
