This coloring book page design was adapted from the October 1929, issue of “Table Talk” – a periodical marketed towards vendors, dealers, and other sellers of Heisey glassware. The advertising design was part of a selection that could be ordered and supplied “free of charge,” in either “mats or electros,” for use in newspapers or similar advertising mediums. The glass pattern (i.e. the design or style) is not specified in the original advertisement; however, the glassware appears to be mostly a selection from pattern number 1184, also colloquially named “Yeoman,” and features Heisey’s “diamond optic.” The Yeoman pattern covers a range of several pattern numbers with and without and was produced between the years 1913-1957.
