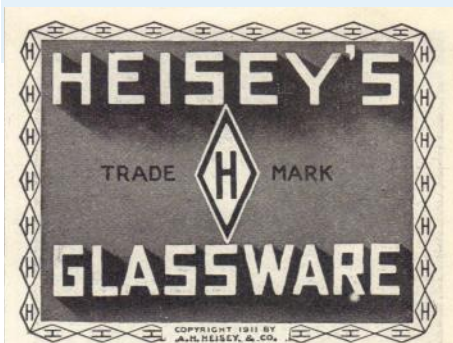

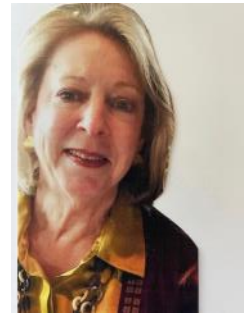

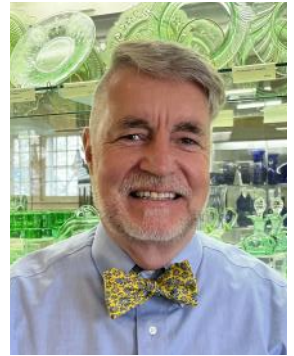

Words from Your Director-Curator



We have six wonderful new holly bushes and four cheery hydrangea plants installed on either side of the lower-level entrance to the King House on the Church Street side. I purchased a new garden hose and multi-pattern nozzle to keep these newly planted items well-watered and off to a good start. The major structural elements of each of the stone sidewalls that this new landscaping surrounds are comprised of two incredible stone polishing wheels from the Heisey factory. With the lack of sun caused by the old, now removed, hedges, many lichens had grown on these four beautiful, important elements of our Heisey history. I switched the hose nozzle from gentle to jet and have, each time I have watered, been working on cleaning these stones off. The two on the west side look better than the two on the east side; however, all four are greatly improved in appearance. I get so excited when I think about the literally hundreds of thousands of pieces of our much beloved Heisey which were finished/polished on these four stones and the hours of skilled hand labor that these gentle giants of stone have been part of. If you are joining us for the convention this year or at any time, I invite you to take a moment to view these important elements of our history.

Treasurer's Report by Andy Baldus



Our financial position continues to remain good through April 2023. Gift shop sales are strong, led by sales of real Heisey and the Heisey mother rabbit reproduction.

First quarter 2023 Financial Report

The following page shows the financial report for the first quarter of 2023. The overall revenues and expenditures for the first quarter are tracking with the approved budget.

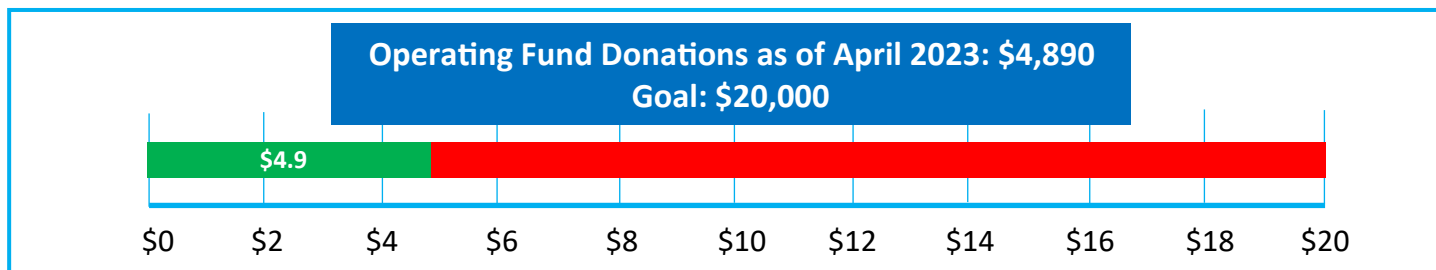
Revenues: Revenues for year-to-date exceeded budgeted levels. This is driven by gift shop sales exceeding expectations by \$2,800, donations to the operating fund, and the first contracts for convention glass show booths. Revenues for two items are below year-to-date budget estimates. Membership is below budget due to how the budget estimates have been broken out by month over the year. The Benefit Auction line shows only pre-auction expenses. The transfer of funds from the endowment fund has been delayed until June.

Expenditures: Expenditures are below the year-to-date budgeted level. The reduced spending on Salary and Wages is due to reduced staffing hours during winter months and the absence of Susan. Other expenses are tracking close to year-to-date budget levels, except for the special project expenses because the delay in the delivery of the mother rabbit also delayed payment. Office supplies and postage expenses exceeded the budgeted amounts due to increased postage charges. Postage expenses are expected to exceed the amount budgeted for the remainder of the year.

2023 ALL HEISEY SPRING BENEFIT AUCTION WRAP-UP

The 49th Annual All-Heisey Spring Benefit Auction was a wonderful event for HCA! We held the auction online and in-person. The in-person portion of our two-day auction returned to the GMP Local #244 Union Hall on Friday-Saturday, April 14–15, 2023. Our auction was well attended with 60 in-person registrants and 102 online registrants. We also had one absentee bidder. We had 907 lots of glass from 31 consignors. Online pre-bidding for the auction started on Friday, April 7, with live bidding starting at 9:30 a.m. ET on April 14 for lots 1–500 and again on April 15 for lots 501–907.

How did we do financially? We grossed \$46,527.50 (glass sales and buyer's premium), and after consignors and expenses are paid, we hope to net approximately \$10,000. Our average price per lot this year was \$51.30, compared to 2022's average of \$66.74.

On behalf of the HCA board of directors and staff, I would like to thank all the volunteers who worked, starting in January 2023, unpacking, identifying, photographing, cataloging, and repacking the glass and then working three straight days until the auction was concluded. You make this event a success and HCA's largest fundraiser.

Special thanks to Walter Ludwig and Eric Tankesley-Clarke who graciously lent their time and Heisey expertise whenever asked; to Jack Burriss and the museum staff, who helped coordinate events in Newark; to Mary Ann Spahr, Lisa Baldus and Karen Taylo, whose work made the event possible; and to Caleb-Michael Files and Doug Olson, who handled the online portion of the auction.

A big thank you goes to Craig Connelly, auctioneer, and his cohorts. They not only sell the glass; they keep us in stitches while doing so! And to GMP Local #244's own Jimmy Gill who worked to assure the hall was in tip-top shape all three days.

Thank you to all the consignors who consigned glass to HCA and to all the auction attendees and absentee/online bidders who purchased that wonderful Heisey glass.

Hope to see all of you at the Dave Spahr Fall Select Auction in October.

2023 HEISEY HERITAGE AUCTION WRAP-UP

The Spring edition of our Heisey Heritage Auction (HHA) was a success! We held the online only auction Saturday, April 8, 2023. The auction was "well attended" with 101 online registrants. We had 372 lots of glass from four consignors. Online pre-bidding for the auction started Saturday, April 1, with live bidding starting at noon ET on April 8.

We grossed \$11,693.70 (glass sales and buyer's premium), and after consignors and expenses are paid, we hope to net approximately \$3500. Our average price per lot for this auction was \$29.11.

The cataloging of the HHA glass coincided with that of the Spring Benefit Auction. Many thanks to all the volunteers from the January sessions, and to the April volunteers who arrived in Newark early to help pack the winning bidders' glass. You are the key to the success of our auctions!

Thanks also to the consignors who consigned to the HHA and to all online bidders who helped make this event a successful fundraiser for HCA.



Tom Bredehoft to Autograph Books at Convention



Dayton Area Heisey Collectors Club News

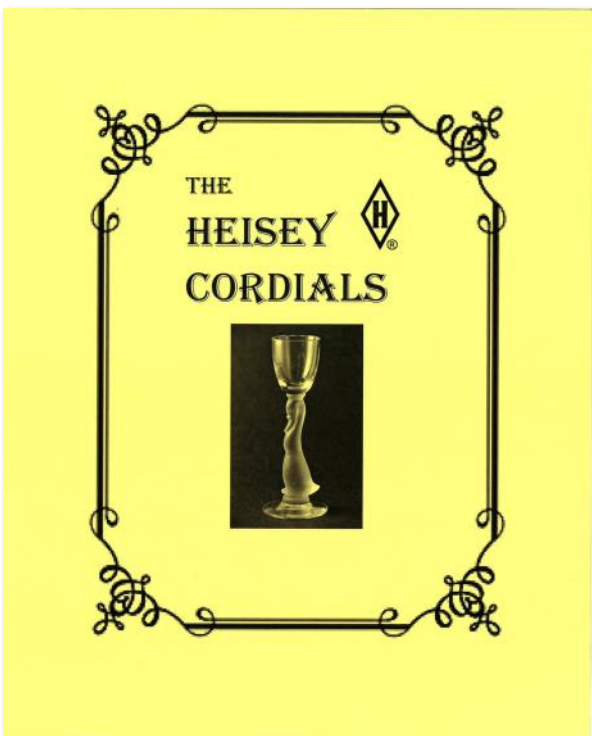

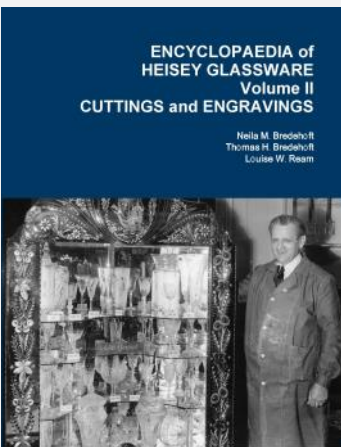
